February Brazil Trip: As I write, we are in Brazil trying to stay cool. The temperatures have reached more than 110 degrees, and we have lost electricity at night which has made for some long, hot nights. The purpose of this trip is to prepare for our permanent move. We turned in all our permanent visa paperwork to the Brazilian government. We have re-evaluated the cost of living in our part of Brazil. Nathan received the Brazilian equivalent of a Social Security Card. This allows us to purchase vehicles, rent a house, and buy appliances.
